St. Vincent's Academy 3HP CENTER (CANTEEN)

St. Vincent's Academy has a Healthy, Happy, Holy Peace (3HP) Center. It serves as a supply store and food service center.

The 3HP center prepares healthy and affordable food items that can make the students happy with their limited resources. It promotes local products from Kauswagan that supports local producers, farmers and fishermen. It also observes environmental practices such as, plastic free, zero waste, waste management, recycling, no carbonated drinks, and others.

The 3HP Center provides space for learning in partnership with the Student Council, CommArts Club and the Learning Resource Center. The students are not only nourished physically but also mentally, and basic respect and kindness that promotes holy lifestyles are practiced.

St. Vincent's Academy HEALING SPACE (CLINIC)

St. Vincent's Academy Clinic is called Healing Space. It provides space for comfort, rest, and first-aid treatment.

It conducts annual medical and dental check-up for students through the help of volunteer doctors, nurses, and dentists from the municipal hospital, alumni, parents, benefactors, and friends.

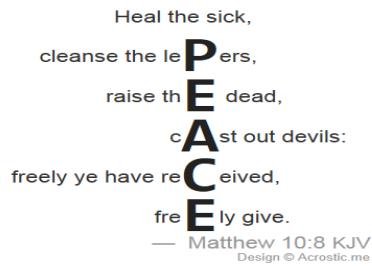
